We are planning on reintroducing face to face meetings with our parents and carers this term to share how well children are settling into their new year groups and where they are in terms of their progress and academic achievements so far.

In light of COVID-19 regulations and to keep the number of adults in school to a minimum and to spread the attendees and evenings out, we will be hosting three sessions.

Session 3	Tuesday 16 November	3-6pm	Year 3 and Year 4 Year 5 and Year 6

We request at this point that only one parent/carer attends to help keep the number of adults in school to an absolute minimum.

COVID-19 Implications

- We will ask parents/carers to sanitise their hands on arrival and to adhere to social distancing rules when inside the building and when meeting with staff.
- If parents/carers wish to wear face coverings, then this is of course your choice but we would ask that you don't bring face coverings in from home but use a brand new disposable face mask provided at the main entrance into school.
- If children can't be collected at 3pm by another member of your family or you need to bring children with you to enable you to attend your appointment we can support you as we have done in previous years by providing childcare in our Computing Suite. The children who can use the Computing Suite must be on roll at St Cuthbert's.
- Any parents/carers who do not wish to have a face to face appointment at this time can opt for a telephone call instead. Please contact the school office directly to arrange this.

We will be sending out appointment options for Monday 8 November to be completed by Monday 18 October. Appointment options for the other two evenings will be shared on Tuesday 19 October.
