Many of you may know that **Natasha's Law** was brought into force last year and supports people, particularly those with food allergies, in making informed decisions about what they are buying and eating. Food producers and sellers now have to include all of the ingredients used to make their products and clear allegen labelling to prevent adverse and sometimes tragic allergic reactions to some ingredients.



We really want to continue to host our Macmillan Fundraiser so, for our coffee morning this year and going forward, we are asking any families who are able, to donate **shopbought cakes**, **buns and biscuits in their original packaging** so those with food allergies can safely participate in this very special event. Please note, we are a '**nut free**' school so please check that the labels on any packaging state that there are **no nuts or nut oils included**.
