

## Admission into Newcastle Primary Schools for September 2023



#### Reception Class Admissions 2023

If your child was born between

1st September 2018 and 31st August 2019,
you need to apply for a place to start
Reception September 2023.







1 September 2022 Admissions process starts

Noon 15 January 2023
Closing date. You must apply for a place by this date

19 April 2023
Reception places are offered

WITHIN TWO WEEKS OF THE OFFER You need to accept an offer of a place

Don't be late! Late applications will **not** be processed until **10 June 2023** 

### Key Points to remember



- ·You will find all the schools in your area by looking on the Newcastle Admissions Website.
- •Read the Admission Policy / guidance for the schools you are applying for carefully (see school websites). See copy of our **St Cuthbert's Admission Policy** 2023/2024.
- ·Make realistic choices (visit the schools/look at websites, understand boundaries of catchment area, transport etc...).
- ·You must submit an application for Reception even if you have an older child in the school.
- ·Use all 4 preferences and put them in order of choice Preference 1 is the school you want most.

Attendance at a school's Nursery does not guarantee a place in that school.

#### st Cuthbert's will ask for ...





If you are applying to St Cuthbert's for faith reasons we will ask you for evidence of faith (certificate of Baptism).

#### We will also ask for:

- Proof of your child's address on official documentation and dated within the last three months.
- Proof of your child's birth date in the form of a birth certificate.

#### Oversubscription Criteria

Where there are more applications for places than the number of places available, places will be offered according to the following order of priority.

First priority in categories 1-5 will be given to children who will have an older sibling attending the school in September 2023.

- 1. Looked after and previously looked after children. (see notes 2&3)
- 2. Catholic children who are resident in the parish of St Cuthbert's, Kenton. (see note 3)
- 3. Other Catholic children. (see note 3)
- 4. Catechumens and members of an Eastern Christian Church. (see notes 4&5)
- 5. Children of other Christian denominations whose membership is evidenced by a minister or faith leader and who will have a sibling attending the school at time of admission. (see note 6)
- 6. Children of other faiths whose membership is evidenced by a minister or faith leader and who will have a sibling attending the school at time of admission. (see note 7)
- 7. Other children who will have a sibling attending the school at time of admission (see note 7).
- 8. Children of other Christian denominations whose membership is evidenced by a minister or faith leader. (see note 6)
- 9. Children of other faiths whose membership is evidenced by a minister or faith leader. (see note 7)
- 10. Any other children.
